

Instant Challenge

Allows your team to learn to:

- Assess a situation
- Define the problem
- Make a plan
- Create solutions quickly

Worth 25% of your team's overall score at a tournament

Task Based ICs

- *What is the task?*
- build, move, change,
- protect or communicate

Performance Based ICs

- You are given scene to plan and perform a skit about
- Needs:
 - Beginning
 - Middle
 - End
- Creative
 - Think outside the box (You don't have build a sandcastle at the beach)
- Use the pencil and paper when planning
- Leave time to practice

Hybrid IC

- A combination of a task and a performance
 - Split the group so part are working on the task and the rest are working on the skit

Roles of Team Members in IC

- Facilitator-
 - Makes sure everyone has chance to give idea and is heard
 - Everyone is working toward the completion of IC
 - Helps decide which idea is best (usually someone everyone listens to)
 - Doesn't take over and tell everyone what to do
- Time keeper- Asks how much time is left and lets team know
 - Person that doesn't like to build or act
 - The person that usually needs a job

- Lawyer-

- Calculates how to get the highest score
- Finds all gimmies (you get x points if done by or in square)
- Makes sure all point areas are completed

Reader-

- Rereads the challenge to make sure what needs to be done or what cannot do
- Asks Appraisers questions when not sure is something is allowed

- Materials Person-

- Counts all materials to make sure have what is on challenge
- Makes sure all materials are available (not on floor or under table)

- Builder(s)-

- Persons that build the best

- Script Writer(s)

- Person that is good writing the script
- Maybe the narrator
